Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

ASPLEY HEATH LANE, TAMWORTH IN ARDEN

Order Commences: 1 September 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 1 September 2021.

FORSHAW HEATH LANE, TANWORTH IN ARDEN

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To enable works for a new water connection.

Order Commences: 1 September 2021 for up to 18 months.

Access & Diversion: Forshaw Heath Lane, Alcester Road, Penn Lane, A435 M42 J3 Roundabout, Forshaw Heath Road and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
