The Metropolitan Borough Of Solihull (Various Roads, Solihull) (Road Closures) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2021

The Council gives notice that it has made the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that all traffic should be restricted or prohibited to ensure that the following works can be undertaken in safety: Town Centre Island, Solihull – all arms off the roundabout will be closed for 5 nights from Monday 6th September 2021 until Saturday 11th September 2021 (20:00hrs to 06:00hrs nights only). Alternative routes for traffic will be signed via Princes Way, Church Hill Road, New Road, Warwick Road, Ashleigh Road, Streetsbrook Road, Sharmans Cross Road and Danford Lane. Vice versa for the opposite direction. Dickens Heath Road, Solihull – between Fulford Hall Lane and Cleobury Lane for 4 nights from Monday 13th September 2021 until Friday 17th September 2021 (20:00hrs to 06:00hrs nights only). Alternative routes for traffic will be signed via Birchy Leasowes Lane and Tilehouse Lane. Vice versa for the opposite direction. Widney Lane, Solihull – between Cranmore Boulevard and Whitefields Road for 6 days from Monday 13th September 2021 until Saturday 18th September 2021 (closed between 09:30hrs and 15:00hrs daily). Alternative routes for traffic will be signed via Cranmore Boulevard, Stratford Road, Dingle Lane and Whitefields Road. Vice versa for the opposite direction. Swanswell Road, Olton – between Merecote Road and Gospel Lane on Thursday 16th September 2021 from 09:00hrs until 17:00hrs. Alternative routes for traffic will be signed via Brook Lane, Kineton Green Road and Gunns Way. Vice versa for the opposite direction. Reason for restrictions: Carriageway Resurfacing. Works on behalf of: Solihull MBC. Access will be maintained through the site for Police, Fire and Ambulance Services responding to emergencies. Pedestrian access to all properties within the restriction and access through the restriction will be maintained along defined routes throughout the period of closure.
