

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT
1984-SECTION 14(1)(a)
THE A446 TRUNK ROAD AND
A452 TRUNK ROAD (COLESHILL
TO STONEBRIDGE) (TEMPORARY
PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company no.9346363) has made an order on the A446 Trunk Road and the A452 Trunk Road, between Coleshill and Stonebridge, in the County of Warwickshire and the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull, to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to –

- a) close the southbound carriageway of the A446 from its roundabout junction with the M6 slip roads at Junction 4, to its junction with the A452, at Little Packington;
- b) close the southbound carriageway of the A452 from its roundabout junction with Solihull Parkway, the B4438 and the link road leading from the A446, to its junction with the southbound carriageway of the A446, at Little Packington; and
- c) close the southbound carriageway of the A452 from its junction with the A446 at Little Packington, to the roundabout junction with the A45, at Stonebridge;
- d) prohibit vehicles entering or leaving the southbound carriageway of the A452 at its junction with Packington Lane at Little Packington.

The work will be carried out over one night between 22:00 hours and 06:00 hours and is expected to start on Tuesday 7 December 2021. The Order will come into force on 30 November 2021.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closures and prohibition. Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

Diversion routes via Coleshill Heath Road, the A452, the B4438 and the A45 will be signed.
