NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an Order on the M42 Motorway, in the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull and in the County of Warwickshire, to enable junction improvement and maintenance works to be carried out. will be to The

  (4) close any emergency refuge area adjacent to the lengths of the M42 described in (2) (a) and (b) above. The work is expected to start on Tuesday 1 February 2022 and continue for approximately forty-two months. The closures will be carried out mainly overnight between 21:30 hours and 05:30 hours with some full weekend closures from 21:30 hours on Friday to 05:30 hours on Monday. The speed restriction and emergency refuge area closures will be in operation from 21:30 hours on Tuesday 1 February 2022 for 24 hours per day for the duration of the works. The Order will come into force on 25 January 2022. Vehicles being used for police, fire and

come into force on 25 January 2022. Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes will be exempt from the speed restrictior and closures. Vehicles being used for special forces purposes will be exempt from the speed restrictions, and vehicles being used for traffic officer purposes, in connection with the works or for winte maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closures.
