

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 14(1)(a) AND 14(7) THE M42 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 4 TO JUNCTION 5) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an Order on the M42 Motorway in the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull, to enable technology and maintenance works to be carried out.

- The effect of the Order will be to close—(1) lanes of the northbound carriageway of the M42 from a point 700 metres northeast of its junction with the entry slip at Junction 4, for a distance of 1510 metres, and allow traffic to run on the hard shoulder; and
- (2) any emergency refuge area adjacent to the lengths of the M42 described in (1) above.

The work will be carried out overnight between 21:00 hours and 06:00 hours and is expected to start on Monday 7 March 2022 and continue for three nights. The order will come into force on 28 February 2022.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closures.
