ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

WELL LANE, TANWORTH IN ARDEN

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from the Junction with The Green (O/S Aspley House) to entrance of new development (Cank Farm/opposite far side of St Mary Magdalene's Church).

Reason for Order: To enable excavation works for disconnection of a gas service.

Order Commences: 14 March 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 18 March 2022.

Access & Diversion: Well Lane, Danzey Green Lane, Mill Lane, Tanworth Lane, Birmingham Road, High Street, New Road, Henley Road, Grimshaw Hill, Barrells Park, Ullenhall Street, Ullenhall Lane, Alcester Road, Beoley Lane, Broad Lane, Vicarage Hill and vice versa.

WHARF LANE, LAPWORTH

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with Stratford Road and intersection of Wharf Lane/Glasshouse Lane.

Reason for Order: To enable works to rebuild a hydrant chamber.

Order Commences: 16 March 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 18 March 2022.

Access & Diversion: Wharf Lane, Stratford Road, Old Warwick Road and vice versa.

Contractor: For Severn Trent Water, Morrisons Utility Services, Tel: 07850 207 579.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
