(St Peters Lane, Bickenhill) (Road Closure) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2022

The Council gives notice that it intends to make the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that all traffic should be restricted or prohibited to ensure that the following works can be undertaken in safety along St Peters Lane, Bickenhill – the short section of the northern slip road from Catherine de Barnes Lane into St. Peters Lane from 00.01hrs on 20th April 2022 until 23.59hrs on 19th October 2023* for realignment works on behalf of Skanska. Access cannot be provided through the restriction for Police, Fire and Ambulance Services responding to emergencies.
