ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

MOWS HILL ROAD, BEAUDESERT

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To enable works for laying duct.

Order Commences: 15 June 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 17 June 2022.

Access & Diversion: Mows Hill Road, Nuthurst Road, Nuthurst Lane, Kemp's Green Road and vice versa.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

VICARAGE HILL, WOOD END

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point outside Yeomans Cottage.

Reason for Order: To enable repair/replacement of a manhole cover.

Order Commences: 24 June 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 24 June 2022.

Access & Diversion: Vicarage Hill, Broad Lane, Alcester Road, Ullenhall Lane, Henley Road, New Road, High Street, A435 Birmingham Road, Tanworth Lane, Mill Lane, Danzey Green Lane, Well Lane, The Green and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
