#### (Ralph Road, Shirley) (20mph Maximum Speed Limit) Order 2022 and The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Ralph Road, Shirley) (Various Provisions) Order 2022

The Council has made these Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The Orders, which comes into force on 7 November 2022, will introduce the following: **Maximum 20mph Speed Limit Access Road to 202-228 Ralph Road (inclusive even), Shirley** – its entire length. **Access Road to 280-300 Ralph Road (inclusive even), Shirley** – its entire length. **Ralph Road, Shirley** – its entire length. **Verstone Road, Shirley** – its entire length. **Blue Badges Only Parking Places Ralph Road, Shirley (north side)** – from a point 150m east of Verstone Road, in an easterly direction, to a point 168m east of that junction. **Total Prohibition of Loading – No Loading at Any Time Ralph Road, Shirley (north side)** – from a point 168m east of Verstone Road, in an easterly direction, to a point 190m east of that junction. **Loading Restrictions – No Loading Monday to Friday (8.00am to 9.30am & 2.45pm to 4.00pm) Ralph Road, Shirley (north side)** – from a point 224m east of Verstone Road, in an easterly direction, to a point 272m east of that junction. **Ralph Road, Shirley (south side)** – from a point 150m east of Verstone Road, in an easterly direction, to a point 200m east of that junction. **Ralph Road, Shirley (south side)** – from a point 233m east of Verstone Road, in an easterly direction, to a point 262m east of that junction. **Total Prohibition of Waiting – No Waiting at Any Time Ralph Road, Shirley (north side)** – From a point 168m east of Verstone Road, in an easterly direction, to a point 190m east of that junction. **Waiting Restrictions – Monday to Friday (8.00am to 9.30am & 2.45pm to 4.00pm) Ralph Road, Shirley (north side)** – from a point 224m east of Verstone Road, in an easterly direction, to a point 272m east of that junction. **Ralph Road, Shirley (south side)** – from a point 150m east of Verstone Road, in an easterly direction, to a point 200m east of that junction. **Ralph Road, Shirley (south side)** – from a point 233m east of Verstone Road, in an easterly direction, to a point 262m east of that junction. **Order Note:** In parallel with the implementation of the above Orders, a humped zebra crossing shall be constructed and commissioned along Ralph Road, Shirley – fronting Streetsbrook Infants & Nursery School.

#### (Meriden Rise and Gaydon Road, Solihull) (Total Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2022

The Order, which comes into force on 3 November 2022, will introduce the following: **Total Prohibition of Waiting – No Waiting at Any Time Meriden Rise (both sides)** – from its junction with Gaydon Road, south-westwards for approx. 20m. **Gaydon Road (south side)** – from a point approx. 15m west of its junction with Meriden Rise, eastwards for approx. 47m.

#### (Woodchester Road, Dorridge) (Footpath Closure) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2022

The Council gives notice that it intends to make the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that all traffic should be restricted or prohibited to ensure that the following works can be undertaken in safety along the footpath between Woodchester Road and Besbury Close, Dorridge from Monday 7 November at 09:00hrs until Monday 14 November 2022 at 18:00hrs.
