The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Braggs Farm Lane, Earlswood) (Road Closure) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2022

The Council gives notice that it has made the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that all traffic should be restricted or prohibited to ensure that the following utility works can be undertaken in safety along Braggs Farm Lane, Earlswood – from its junction with Lady Lane to outside of property 'Holly Cottage' on Braggs Farm Lane from Thursday 8 December 2022 at 08:00hrs until Wednesday 14 December 2022 at 16:00hrs.
