ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

CHURCH LANE, LAPWORTH

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with Tapster Lane and Old Warwick Road.

Reason for Order: To enable works for the installation of a boundary box.

Order Commences: 1 February 2023 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 3 February 2023.

Access & Diversion: Church Lane, Spring Lane, Wharf Lane, Old Warwick Road and vice versa.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

ROTHERHAMS OAK LANE, EARLSWOOD

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between junctions of School Road and Cut Throat Lane.

Reason for Order: To safely enable utility works on behalf of Openreach. Road closed between 09.30hrs-15.30hrs.

Order Commences: 15 February 2023 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 16 February 2023.

Access & Diversion: Cut Throat Lane, Dyers Lane, School Road and vice versa.

SURFACE DRESSING 2023 SOUTH WARWICKSHIRE

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic and temporary 10mph speed limits imposed on the roads as indicated in the Schedule below:

Anticipated Completion: 27 October 2023.
