##### (Total Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2022

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. ##### (Various Road, Solihull) (40mph Maximum Speed Limit) Order 2022

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and all other enabling powers. The Order, which comes into force on 20 April 2023, will introduce the following: **40mph Maximum Speed Limit Bickenhill Ward Old Damson Lane** – From its junction with Damson Parkway, north-eastwards to its junction with the A45 Coventry Road. **Meriden Ward Table Oak Lane** – From a point approx. 22m west from its junction with Meer End Road, westwards to its junction with Honiley Road. **Holly Lane** – From its junction with Brees Lane, northwards for approx. 200m. **Brees Lane** – From a point approx. 73m north of its junction with Honiley Road, northwards to its junction with Table Oak Lane. **Honiley Road** – From a point approx. 200m northwest of its junction with Brees Lane (roundabout), north-westwards to its junction with Table Oak Lane. **Fen End Road** – From its junction with Table Oak Lane, north-westwards for approx. 565m. **Berkswell Road** – From its junction with Cornets End Lane, northwards for approx. 800m. **Meriden Road** – From its junction with Cornets End Lane, southwards for approx. 90m. **Dorridge & Hockley Heath Ward Box Trees Road** – From a point approx. 90m north-west of its junction with Stratford Road, north-eastwards for approx. 1090m. **Earlswood Road** – From its junction with Box Trees Road, eastwards for approx. 200m.
