

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

OUTWOODS LANE & MAXSTOKE LANE, GREAT PACKINGTON

Order Effect: Roads closed to vehicular traffic as follows: Outwoods Lane – from a point outside Parsonage Farm and Maxstoke Lane – from a point opposite Burnet Iron Lodge.

Reason for Order: To enable works for replacement of BT poles.

Order Commences: 10 May 2023 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 11 May 2023.
