## **HIGH SPEED RAIL (LONDON – WEST MIDLANDS) ACT 2017 THE A452 CHESTER ROAD/A446 STONEBRIDGE ROAD (HIGH SPEED TWO (PHASE ONE)) (TRUNKING) ORDER 202X**

THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR TRANSPORT hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under Section 3 of the High Speed Rail (London - West Midlands) Act 2017 and the provisions of paragraph 13 in part 3 of Schedule 4 of that Act which will authorise that the A446 Link Road, A452 Chester Road Northbound and Southbound Slip Roads and A446 Stonebridge Road Northbound Slip Road shall become trunk roads and for which National Highways Company Limited, as a strategic highways company, will be directed under the Order shall become the highway authority for those trunk roads from the date when the Order comes into force.

ANY PERSON MAY OBJECT to the making of this Order not later than 14 September 2023 by writing to the Secretary of State for Transport at his address of the National Transport Casework Team, Tyneside House, Skinnerburn Road, Newcastle Business Park, Newcastle upon Tyne NE4 7AR, or by email to [nationalcasework@dft.gov.uk](mailto:nationalcasework@dft.gov.uk), stating the title of the Order and the grounds of their objection. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of grounds of objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.

In submitting an objection or representation it should be noted that your personal data and correspondence will be passed to HS2 Ltd to enable your objection or representation to be considered. If you do not wish your personal data to be forwarded, please state your reasons when submitting your objection or representation and the Secretary of State will copy your representations, with your name and address removed, to HS2 Ltd.
