The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (B4101 Kelsey Lane and Windmill Lane, Balsall Common) (20mph Maximum Speed Limit) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023

The Council gives notice that it intends to make the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that all traffic should be restricted or prohibited to ensure that the following works can be undertaken in safety: B4101 Kelsey Lane, Balsall Common – from its junction with A452 Kenilworth Road to a point approximately 50m east of its junction with Windmill Lane. Windmill Lane, Balsall Common – from its junction with the B4101 Kelsey Lane/Waste Lane to a point approximately 126m south of that junction from Sunday 1st September 2023 for a period of up to 18 months (up to 31st March 2025). Reason for restriction: Speed reduction for workforce and traffic safety. Works on behalf of: HS2. Exemptions: Police, Fire and Ambulance Services responding to emergencies. (Kyter Lane, Castle Bromwich) (Road Closure) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023

The Council gives notice that it has made the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that all traffic should be restricted or prohibited to ensure that the following works can be undertaken in safety along Kyter Lane, Castle Bromwich – between the junctions of Kingsleigh Drive and Rectory Lane from Monday 28th August 2023 at 08:00hrs until Friday 8th September 2023 at 16:00hrs. Reason for restriction: Meter installation works. Works on behalf of: Severn Trent Water. Diversion route: Signed via Kingsleigh Drive, Beechcroft Road, Chester Road & (back onto) Kyter Lane. Vice versa for the opposite direction. Access **will** be maintained through the site for Police, Fire and Ambulance Services responding to emergencies. Pedestrian access to all properties within the restriction and access through the restriction will be maintained along defined routes throughout the period of closure.
