ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

SHUTT LANE, EARLSWOOD

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point outside property number 94.

Reason for Order: To enable works for a new water connection.

Order Commences: 11 October 2023 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 13 October 2023.

Access & Diversion: Shutt Lane, Salter Street, Tanworth Lane, Lady Lane, Dickens Heath Road, Rumbush Lane, Fulford Hall Road, Norton Lane, Valley Road and vice versa.

TAPSTER LANE, LAPWORTH

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: Access to telegraph poles in order to provide fibre overhead cabling.

Order Commences: 13 October 2023 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 13 October 2023.

Access & Diversion: Tapster Lane, Bushwood Lane, Lapworth Street, Yew Tree Lane and vice versa.

PACKWOOD ROAD, LAPWORTH

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To enable works for the installation of an electricity supply.

Order Commences: 18 October 2023 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 25 October 2023.

Access & Diversion: Packwood Road, Vicarage Road, Chessetts Wood Road, Rising Lane, Packwood Lane and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
