(Total Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2023

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for this Order can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via <https://www.solihull.gov.uk/Roads-pavements-and-streetcare//Traffic-regulation-orders> A copy of the Order is available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 12 February 2024, will introduce the following: **Total Prohibition of Waiting – No Waiting at Any Time**
Solihull Road (northern side) – from its junction with Stanway Road, north-eastwards for approximately 30 metres.
Solihull Road (southern side) – from its junction with Radbourne Road, north-eastwards for approximately 20 metres.
Radbourne Road (eastern side) – from its junction with Solihull Road, south-eastwards for approximately 52 metres (to join the existing double yellow lines).
Radbourne Road (western side) – from its junction with Solihull Road, south-eastwards for approximately 18 metres.
Stanway Road (eastern side) – from its junction with Solihull Road, north-westwards for approximately 22 metres.
Stanway Road (western side) – from its junction with Solihull Road, north-westwards for approximately 23 metres.
