

**The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull
(Tanhouse Farm Road, Farmstead Road and
Farm Close, Solihull)
(Total Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2023**

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 22 March 2024, will introduce the following: **Total Prohibition of Waiting – No Waiting at Any Time** **Tanhouse Farm Road (north-eastern side)** – from a point approximately 23 metres north-west of its junction with Farmstead Road, south-eastwards for approximately 86 metres. **Tanhouse Farm Road (south-western side)** – from a point approximately 35 metres north-west of its junction with Farmstead Road, south-eastwards for approximately 119 metres. **Farmstead Road (north-western side)** – from its junction with Tanhouse Farm Road, south-westwards for approximately 41 metres. **Farmstead Road (south-eastern side)** – from its junction with Tanhouse Farm Road, south-westwards for approximately 72 metres. **Farm Close (north-western side)** – from its junction with Tanhouse Farm Road in a northerly direction for approximately 44 metres. **Farm Close (south-eastern side)** – from its junction with Tanhouse Farm Road in a northerly direction for approximately 44 metres. **Farm Close** – Entire perimeter of green space at the north-eastern extent of the cul-de-sac, a total distance of approximately 65 metres.

(Hobs Moat Road Service Road, Solihull) (Road Closure) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2024
The Council gives notice that it has made the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that all traffic should be restricted or prohibited to ensure that the following works can be undertaken in safety along Hobs Moat Road Service Road, Solihull – fronting Solihull Ice Rink from Monday 18th March 2024 at 09:30 until Tuesday 26th March 2024 at 15:30hrs. Reason for restriction: Installation of Speed Table and Bollards. Works on behalf of: TfWM. Diversion route: Hobs Moat Road. Access **will** be maintained through the site for Police, Fire and Ambulance Services responding to emergencies.
