

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTIONS 14(1)(a) AND (7) AND 15(2) THE À45, A446 ÀND A452 TRUNK ROADS (STONEBRIDGE **ROUNDABOUT TO M6 JUNCTION 4 ROUNDABOUT)** (TEMPORARY RESTRICTION AND PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

ORDER 2024 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited

(Company no. 9346363) intends to make an Order on the A45, the A446 and the A452 Trunk Roads, in the County of Warwickshire and in the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull to enable bridge demolition and associated works in connection with High Speed 2 railway works.

The effect of the Order, will be to, at different times, (1) impose a speed limit, according to the signs displayed at the

- time, of either 50 miles per hour or 40 miles per hour on (a) the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A452 and the slip roads leading to and from the A45 (Stonebridge Roundabout), at Stonebridge;
 - (b) northbound carriageway of the A452 from its junction with Stonebridge Roundabout, to its junction with the A446;
 - (c) the northbound carriageway of the A446 from its junction with the A452, to the tip of the nosing at its junction with the slip road leading from the the new northern roundabout junction of the A446 and the A452 Chester Road (Northern Roundabout), near Little Packington;
 - (d) the southbound carriageway of the A446 from the tip of the nosing at its junction with the slip road leading to the Northern Roundabout, to its junction with the A452;
 - (e) the southbound carriageway of the A452 from its junction with the A446, to its junction with Stonebridge Roundabout
 - the exit slip road leading from the eastbound carriageway (f) of the A45 to Stonebridge Roundabout
- (2) close
 - (a) the northbound carriageway of the A452 from its junction with Stonebridge Roundabout to its junction with the A446;
 - (b) the northbound carriageway of the A446 from its junction with the A452, to its roundabout junction with the M6 Junction 4 slip roads (M6 Junction 4 Roundabout);
 - (c) the southbound carriageway of the A446 from its junction with M6 Junction 4 Roundabout, to its junction with the A452; and
 - (d) the southbound carriageway of the A452 from its junction with the A446, to its junction with Stonebridge Roundabout northbound carriageway of the A452 from its junction with Stonebridge Roundabout to its junction with the A446;
 - (e) the circulatory carriageway of Stonebridge Roundabout;
 - the layby adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the (f) A452 approximately 975 metres north of the centrepoint of Stonebridge Roundabout; and
- (g) the footway adjacent to Stonebridge Roundabout between the junction with the exit slip road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the A45, and the entry to the northbound carriageway of the A452; and (3) prohibit any vehicle with an overall width exceeding 6"6"
 - (2 metres) from entering or proceeding in -
 - (a) the lengths of trunk road described in (2)(a), (b), (c) and (d) above;
 - (b) the entry slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A446 from Northern Roundabout; and
 - (c) the entry slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A452 from the new southern roundabout junction of the
- A446 and the A452 Chester Road, near Little Packington. The work is expected to start on Monday 15 July 2024 and

continue for nineteen months. The Order will come into force on 12 July 2024. Any vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or

ambulance purposes will be exempt from the speed restrictions, closures and prohibition. Special forces vehicles will be exempt from the speed restrictions. Vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closures and prohibition. Pedestrians engaged in police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance related activities or activities related to the work will be exempt from the footway closures.

Diversion routes via the A45, Bickenhill Lane, the A452 Chester Road and Coleshill Heath Road and vice versa will be signed.
