Welford-on-Avon Neighbourhood Development Plan Referendum

The Welford-on-Avon Neighbourhood Plan was independently examined in November 2015 and the Examiner recommended that, subject to some proposed modifications, the Plan should proceed to referendum.

The District Council agrees with the Examiner's report and Members voted to progress the Plan to referendum at a meeting of The Cabinet on 31 July this year. The referendum will be asking whether the community wish to see the District Council use the Neighbourhood Plan to decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area (which is based on the Parish boundary).

In accordance with the Neighbourhood Planning (Referendum) Regulations 2012 (as amended) the Local Planning Authority must publicise the referendum for a minimum of 28 working days prior to the date of the referendum.

The referendum for the Welford-on-Avon Neighbourhood Plan will be held on Thursday 12 October 2017. The polling station will be the Welford and Weston Memorial Hall, High Street, Welford-on-Avon CV37 8EF

A number of documents (referred to as 'specified documents' in the Regulations) have been produced in order to help you make a decision on how to vote.
