## **Long Itchington, Bascote and Bascote Heath Neighbourhood Development Plan Consultation - Regulation 16**

Notice is given that Long Itchington Parish Council as the Qualifying Body has prepared a Neighbourhood Development Plan entitled the 'Long Itchington, Bascote and Bascote Heath Neighbourhood Plan 2011-2031' for their Parish with the help of the local community. The plan sets out a vision for the future of the Parish and planning policies which will be used to determine planning applications locally. In accordance with Regulation 16 of Part 5 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended), the Local Planning Authority must publicise the draft plan for a minimum 6 week period inviting representations on the plan.
