

STRATFORD-ON-AVON DISTRICT COUNCIL TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING (REFERENDUM) REGULATIONS 2012 (AS AMENDED)

Southam Neighbourhood Development Plan Referendum

The Southam Neighbourhood Plan was independently examined between December and March 2023 and the Examiner recommended that, subject to a small number of proposed modifications, the Plan should proceed to referendum.

Following that consultation, the District Council has now issued a Decision Statement on the Southam Neighbourhood Plan and the Portfolio Holder for Place at the District Council has endorsed the recommendation to proceed to referendum. The referendum will be asking whether the community wish to see the District Council use the Neighbourhood Plan to decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area (which is based on the Parish boundary).

In accordance with the Neighbourhood Planning (Referendum) Regulations 2012 (as amended) the Local Planning Authority must publicise the referendum for a minimum of 28 days prior to the date of the referendum. The referendum for the Southam Neighbourhood Plan will be held on Thursday 22 June 2023.

 In Southam East the polling station is The Sports and Social Club (Rear Entrance),

- Southam, CV47 2WF
