

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D6564 ILMINGTON ROAD, BLACKWELL

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D6564 Ilmington Road, Blackwell, from the junction of Darlingscote Road to the junction of New Bridges Farm Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate road widening works.

The Order will commence on 14 November 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 4 December 2016.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Ilmington Road, Tredington Road, Darlingscote Road, Armscote Road, Blackwell Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C49 ARMSCOTE ROAD, ILMINGTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing C49 Armscote Road, Ilmington, from the Severn Trent Water Sewerage Works Site to the junction with Front Street, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for carriageway resurfacing works.

The Order will commence on 14 November 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 18 November 2016.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Ilmington Road, Halford Road, Shipston Road, Wimpstone Lane, Ilmington Road, Stratford Road (and in reverse order).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS SD143 IN THE PARISH OF HAMPTON LUCY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpaths SD143 in the Parish of Hampton Lucy, between grid reference: SP22587-57124 and grid reference: SP22631-57174, to all traffic.

The closure is required for public safety to avoid danger, or the likelihood of danger to the public as the result of the erosion of the river bank along which the footpath runs.

The Order will commence on 18 November 2016 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until remedial works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed, if any, will be maintained.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF IDLICOTE ROAD, HONINGTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Idlicote Road, Honington from the A3400 to the village, a distance of approximately 400 metres, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate the structural inspection of a bridge crossing the River Stour.

The Order will commence on 12 November 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed 18 November 2016.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed, if any, will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be appropriately signed.
