

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BEOLEY LANE, TANWORTH IN ARDEN

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Beoley Lane, Tanworth in Arden, from its junction with Broad Lane, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to safely facilitate works on a sluice valve.

The Order will commence on 13 December 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 15 December 2016.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Broad Lane (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WINDMILL HILL, TEMPLE GRAFTON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Windmill Hill, Temple Grafton, at a point approximately 460 metres from its junction with Wixford Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works to build a chamber in the verge and to install poly duct.

The Order will commence on 15 December 2016 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 19 December 2016.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Windmill Hill, Evesham Road, Wixford Road, Bidford Road, Temple Grafton Road, Ardens Grafton Road, New Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C41 WOOD LANE, GREAT ALNE

The closure is required to facilitate drainage works.

(STRATFORD ROAD, HAMPTON LUCY) (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2016

Warwickshire County Council have made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to impose a 30 mph speed limit on the length of road described in the Schedule below. The Order commences on Monday 28 November 2016.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C72 GOLDICOTE ROAD, LOXLEY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing C72 Goldicote Road, Loxley, between Dancers Lane junction and Goldicote Lodge, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for carriageway resurfacing.
