

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C47 STATION ROAD, LONG MARSTON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing C47 Station Road, Long Marston, from its junction with B4632 Campden Road for a distance of approximately 600 metres, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for carriageway resurfacing works.

The Order will commence on 6 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 17 February 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Long Marston Road, Mickleton To Long Marston Road, Long Marston Lane, Stratford Road, Campden Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ADMINGTON ROAD, PRESTON ON STOUR

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Admington Road, Preston on Stour to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works to replace defective repairs to the road surface.

The Order will commence on 10 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 12 February 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Wimpstone Road, Ilmington Road, Stratford Road, Admington Road, Harbour Hill (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOSSE WAY, BLACKWELL

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Fosse Way, Blackwell, in the Lay By area for a distance of approximately 310 metres, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of a new HV utility cable.

The Order will commence on 6 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 13 February 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BLACKWELL ROAD, BLACKWELL

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Blackwell Road, Blackwell to vehicular traffic.

Blackwell Road	Heading north towards Shipston Road for approximately 785 metres	10/02/17 to 17/03/17	Blackwell Road, Darlingscott Road, Fosse Way (and vice versa)

The Order will commence on 10 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 17 March 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SHIPSTON ROAD, BLACKWELL

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of a HV utility cable.

The Order will commence on 7 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20 February 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Darlingscote Road, Tredington Road (and vice versa).
