

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH AL3 IN THE PARISH OF SALFORD PRIORS

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpath AL3 in the Parish of Salford Priors (Grid reference; 811629, 503836), to all traffic. The closure is required for reasons of safety because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near to the footpath.

The Order will commence on 1 February 2017 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF INGON LANE, SNITTERSFIELD

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Ingon Lane, Snittersfield, from a point outside Ingon Grange to a point approximately 350 metres south, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate network cabling works for a new customer connection.

The Order will commence on 12 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. The work will be carried out between 06.00hrs and 16.00hrs with anticipation of completion by 16.00hrs on 13 February 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Ingon Lane, Warwick Road, Sand Barn Lane, A46 from junction with A3400 to junction with A439, Stratford Northern Bypass, Kings Lane (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A3400 ALVESTON MANOR ROUNDABOUT, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing A3400 Alveston Manor Roundabout, Stratford upon Avon, from the Banbury Road junction with Tiddington Road to the Alveston Manor Hotel entrance, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for carriageway resurfacing.

The Order will commence on 30 January 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 3 February 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Trinity Way, Seven Meadows Road, Evesham Place, Grove Road, Arden Street, Birmingham Road, Guild Street, Bridgeway and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DONNINGTON ROAD, SHIPSTON ON STOUR

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Donnington Road, Shipston on Stour, from a point outside property number 1 to a point at the side of 40 Mayo Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation and renewal of long comm and short comm pipes.

The Order will commence on 13 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 24 February 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Donnington Road, Mayo Road (and vice versa)

Please Note: Access to the medical centre will be maintained.

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PART OF FOOTPATH SD23 & SD23A TEMPLE GRAFTON) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2016

On 24 January 2017 Warwickshire County Council confirmed and certified the above Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed and certified will DIVERT Footpath SD23 from Point A on Hillborough Lane (GR 41241 25219) running generally south south west for approximately 264 metres to Point B (GR 41235 25193) then generally west for approximately 279 metres to Point C (GR 41207 25193) TO A LINE From Point E on Hillborough Lane (GR 41231 25223), running generally south south west for approximately 343 metres to Point D (GR 41217 25193), then generally west for approximately 100 metres to Point C (GR 41207 25193). DIVERT SD23a from its junction with SD23 at Point F (GR 41231 25192) running generally south west for approximately 238 metres to Point G (GR 41210 25181) TO A LINE from SD23 at Point C (GR 41207 25193) running generally south south east for approximately 115 metres to Point G (GR 41210 25181). The diversions are shown on the Order Plan and the new paths will have a width of 3 metres.

The Order comes into force on 24 January 2017, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or if any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 26 January 2017, make an application to the High Court.
