

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MIDDLEFIELD LANE, NEWBOLD ON STOUR

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Middlefield Lane, Newbold on Stour from the junction with Stratford Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for carriageway resurfacing.

The Order will commence on 2 March 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 3 March 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TYSOE ROAD, RADWAY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Tysoe Road, Radway from the junction with King John's Lane to the junction with Tysoe Road/West End, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for carriageway patching works. The Order will commence on 2 March 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 2 March 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Tysoe Road, Farnborough Road, Banbury Road, Banbury Street, Bridge Street, Tysoe Road, Banbury Road and Vice Versa.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D6080 STRATFORD ROAD, STRATFORD UPON AVON & TEMPORARY 10 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION A439 WARWICK ROAD, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D6080 Stratford Road, Stratford upon Avon from the junction with Warwick Road for a distance of approximately 345 metres in an easterly direction to vehicular traffic & imposing a temporary 10mph speed restriction to all traffic on A439 Warwick Road, Stratford upon Avon.

The closure and the speed restriction are necessary for the safety of all road users and of the contractors while resurfacing works are in progress.

The Order will commence on 2 March 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 6 March 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: St James Road, Welsh Road, Coventry Street and vice versa.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CAMPDEN ROAD, SHIPSTON ON STOUR

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Campden Road, Shipston on Stour, service road only, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the renewal of a hydrant and rebuilding of a sluice valve chamber.

The Order will commence on 27 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 10 March 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PAYTON STREET, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Payton Street, Stratford upon Avon, from the junction with Warwick Road to a point outside property number 10 (a distance of approximately 100 metres), to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the removal of a standby generator and the installation of a new generator in the BT exchange in the Premier Inn.

The Order will commence on 28 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 28 February 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained where possible.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF INGON LANE, SNITTERSFIELD

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Ingon Lane, Snittersfield, from a point outside Ingon Grange to a point approximately 350 metres south, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate network cabling works for a new customer connection. 06.00hrs to 16.00hrs

The Order will commence on 12 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. The work will be carried out between 06.00hrs and 16.00hrs with anticipation of completion by 16.00hrs on 12 February 2017.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DONNINGTON ROAD, SHIPSTON ON STOUR

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Donnington Road, Shipston on Stour, from a point outside property number 1 to a point at the side of 40 Mayo Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation and renewal of long comm and short comm pipes.

The Order will commence on 13 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 24 February 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH BETWEEN ANSON CLOSE AND DOVEHOUSE DRIVE, WELLESBOURNE

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing the Public Footpath between Anson Close and Dovehouse Drive, Wellesbourne to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate duct laying works in the footway.

The Order will commence on 28 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 2 March 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed, if any, will be maintained at all times.

## TEMPORARY 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT – B4632 CAMPDEN ROAD, LONG MARSTON

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order the effect of which was to impose a temporary speed limit of 30 mph, on the above named road from the junction with Main Road and for a distance of 400 metres northwards as indicated by signage, for all traffic.

The temporary speed limit was required for the safety of all road users and of the Contractors working on or near to the carriageway.

The Order commenced on 1 August 2016 for a period of 18 months, or until the works to which it related were completed, whichever was the earlier.

Due to unforeseen circumstances commencement of the work on the carriageway, as advertised, was delayed. However work has now been rescheduled to commence 13 February 2017, the 30mph restriction will be in force for the duration of the works.

It is anticipated that the works on the carriageway will be completed on or before 17 February 2017.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HEATH END LANE, SNITTERFIELD

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Heath End Lane, Snitterfield to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the clearance of cable blockages.

The Order will commence on 1 March 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 7 March 2017.
