

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF KINETON ROAD, WELLESBOURNE

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Kineton Road, Wellesbourne from the junction with Walton Park to the junction with (but not including) the Fosseyway Roundabout, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for carriageway resurfacing works. The Order will commence on 15 March 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 27 March 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Kineton Road, Fosseyway, Banbury Road, Ettington Road and vice versa.

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF STRATFORD ON AVON) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION NO. 27) ORDER 2017

Warwickshire County Council have made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to vary the existing District of Stratford on Avon (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2008, as briefly described (by approximate measurements) in the Schedule below. The Order commences on Monday 27 February 2017.

Exceptions to any waiting restrictions described in the Schedule below will permit waiting for the purposes of picking up and setting down passengers, for vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge and in connection with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water or electricity.

A copy of the Order, together with a copy of the Order to be varied, plans showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the Warwickshire County Council Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick; at Stratford on Avon District Council, Elizabeth House, Church Street, Stratford on Avon; at the (Temporary) Public Library at Stratford ArtsHouse, 14 Rother Street, Stratford upon Avon; and at the Henley Community Library, The Old Schoolroom, Henley-in-Arden Methodist Church, High Street, Henley in Arden during usual opening hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D6080 STRATFORD ROAD, STRATFORD UPON AVON & TEMPORARY 10 MPH SPEED RESTRICTION A439 WARWICK ROAD, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D6080 Stratford Road, Stratford upon Avon from the junction with Warwick Road for a distance of approximately 345 metres in an easterly direction to vehicular traffic & imposing a temporary 10mph speed restriction to all traffic on A439 Warwick Road, Stratford upon Avon. The closure and speed restriction are required to safely facilitate carriageway resurfacing.

The Order will commence on 2 March 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 6 March 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TYSOE ROAD, RADWAY

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH BETWEEN ANSON CLOSE AND DOVEHOUSE DRIVE, WELLESBOURNE

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing the Public Footpath between Anson Close and Dovehouse Drive, Wellesbourne to all traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate duct laying works in the footway.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PAYTON STREET, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Payton Street, Stratford upon Avon, from the junction with Warwick Road to a point outside property number 10 (a distance of approximately 100 metres), to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the removal of a standby generator and the installation of a new generator in the BT exchange in the Premier Inn.

The Order will commence on 28 February 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 28 February 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HEATH END LANE, SNITTERFIELD

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CAMPDEN ROAD, SHIPSTON ON CAMDEN
