

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PENNYFORD LANE, WOOTTON WAWEN

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Pennyford Lane, Wootton Wawen from the junction of Stratford Road and for a distance of approximately 350 metres in a southerly direction, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate overhead BT works.

The Order will commence on 28 July 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 July 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Pennyford Lane, Alcester Road, Wootton Rise, Stratford Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D6209 CHURCH LANE, SHOTTERY

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D6209 Church Lane, Shotton from the junction of Bell Lane for a distance of approximately 100 metres, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate remedial works to sewer trenches.

The Order will commence on 24 July 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 27 July 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FRIZ HILL, WELLESBOURNE

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Friz Hill, Wellesbourne from a point opposite the entrance to Friz Hill Farm, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the connection of new water supplies.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CAMPDEN ROAD, STRETTON ON FOSSE

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Campden Road, Stretton on Fosse from a point outside the entrance to Ditchford Farm to the junction with the Fosse Way, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the diversion of a water main.

The Order will commence on 7 August 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 11 September 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY 10MPH SPEED RESTRICTION AND

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A422 BANBURY ROAD, STRATFORD UPON AVON

The speed restriction is needed for the safety of all road users and of the contractors working in the carriageway for surface dressing preparation; the closure is required to facilitate surface dressing works.

The Speed Restriction Order will commence on 27 July 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

The Closure Order will commence 5 August 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
