

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LONGDON ROAD, DARLINGSSCOTT

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Longdon Road, Darlingscott from the junction with Darlingscott Road and for a distance of 0.1 miles in a south westerly direction, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate the access required to underground BT structure to provide service.

The Order will commence on 12 August 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 12 August 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Longdon Road, Campden Road, Fosse Way, Blackwell Road, Darlingscott Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FORD LANE, LANGLEY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Ford Lane, Langley from its junction with Langley Road to the Railway Bridge, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate tree trimming around the power lines.

The Order will commence on 16 August 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed between 09.00hrs and 16.00hrs on 16 August 2017.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF B4455 FOSSE WAY, PILLERTON HERSEY

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D6568 DARLINGSCOTTE ROAD, STRETTON ON FOSSE
