

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FRIZ HILL, WELLESBOURNE

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Friz Hill, Wellesbourne from a point opposite the entrance to Friz Hill Farm, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the connection of new water supplies.

The Order will commence on 8 August 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 11 August 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Friz Hill, Bowshot Island, Fosse Way, Wellesbourne Road, Staple Hill, Kineton Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CAMPDEN ROAD, STRETTON ON FOSSE

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Campden Road, Stretton on Fosse from a point outside the entrance to Ditchford Farm to the junction with the Fosse Way, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the diversion of a water main.

The Order will commence on 7 August 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 11 September 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Campden Road, Fosse Way, Darlingscott Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TELEGRAPH STREET, SHIPSTON ON STOUR

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Telegraph Street, Shipston on Stour, from the junction of Church Street to a point outside Rotherwick Court, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate works for the replacement of a broken manhole.

The Order will commence on 22 August 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 22 August 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Church Street, Station Road, The Driftway, Telegraph Street (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A422 BANBURY ROAD, KINETON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing A422 Banbury Road, Kineton, from its junction with D6429 Tysoe Road to its junction with C54 Tysoe Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway resurfacing works.

The Order will commence on 23 August 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 30 August 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
