

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MEER STREET, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Meer Street, Stratford upon Avon from Rother Street to Henley Street to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to safely facilitate works for the installation of a road crossing and removal of spoil during excavations.

The Order will commence on 16 September 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 23 October 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Meer Street, Wood Street, Market Cross, Union Street, Guild Street, Birmingham Road, Arden Street, Greenhill Street (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WHITLEY ROAD, HENLEY IN ARDEN

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Whitley Road, Henley in Arden from a point adjacent to property number 36, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the connection of new water plots.

The Order will commence on 18 September 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20 September 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Whitley Road, Arden Road, Meadow Road, Mount Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C53 OXHILL ROAD, KINETON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing C53 Oxhill Road, Kineton from C54 Tysoe Road to the A422 Banbury Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway resurfacing works.

The Order will commence on 5 October 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 12 October 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Tysoe Road, A422 Banbury Road and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LONG MARSTON ROAD, LONG MARSTON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Long Marston Road, Long Marston from the junction of Station Road to the junction of the road to Broad Marston, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the construction of a new sewage rising main from the Railway Bridge into Long Marston.

The Order will commence on 2 October 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 3 November 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Long Marston Road, Station Road, Campden Road, Stratford Road, Long Marston Lane, Mickleton to Long Marston Road (and vice versa).
