

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VILLAGE ROAD, WALTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Village Road, Walton for a distance of approximately 100 metres, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of a duct in the verge and carriageway.

The Order will commence on 26 September 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 September 2017. Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SNITTERFIELD ROAD, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Snitterfield Road, Stratford upon Avon to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate urgent sewer repair works.

The Order will commence on 9 October 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20 October 2017.

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (HENLEY STREET, STRATFORD UPON AVON) (PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES) (EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2017

Warwickshire County Council have made the above Experimental Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from that length of Henley Street, Stratford upon Avon which is described in the Schedule below at all times.

The Experimental Order commences on Monday 2 October 2017 and lasts for a period of up to 18 months.

The Experimental Order contains exemptions for the emergency services and statutory undertakers.

A copy of the Experimental Order, together with a plan showing the length of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Experimental Order may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick and at Stratford on Avon District Council, Elizabeth House, Church Street, Stratford upon Avon and at the Public Library, Henley Street, Stratford upon Avon during usual opening hours.

In due course, Warwickshire County Council will be considering whether the provisions of the Experimental Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Any person may object to the making of such a permanent order on or before 2 April 2018 (or if the Experimental Order is varied or modified pursuant to the 1984 Act, within a period of six months commencing on the day on which the variation or modification came into force). Objections, and the name of the objector, will normally be treated as public information and may be published.

That length of Henley Street, Stratford upon Avon which extends from a point at its northern end 19 metres south-east of its junction with the kerb-line of the east side of Windsor Street, to its junction with Meer Street.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D6639 FELL MILL LANE, BARCHESTON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D6639 Fell Mill Lane, Barcheston from Leason Road to B4035 Brailes Road, to vehicular traffic.
