

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF KISSING TREE WAY, ALVESTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Kissing Tree Way, Alveston from a point outside "The Stable" to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate works for a new electricity service.

The Order will commence on 23 October 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 26 October 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Kissing Tree Way, Church Lane, Alveston Leys, The Rookery, Kissing Tree Lane (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WILMCOTE LANE, ASTON CANTLOW

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Wilmcote Lane, Aston Cantlow from the junction of Aston Cantlow Road to the junction of Brook Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate BT cabling works for Fibre Network.

The Order will commence on 25 October 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 27 October 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Wilmcote Lane, Brook Road, Burbage Road, Bearley Road, Pear Tree Gardens, Whitehouse Hill, Salters Lane, Bearley Cross, Birmingham Road, Featherbed Lane, Station Road, Aston Cantlow Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHAPEL LANE, STRATFORD UPON AVON

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D6236 WATERSIDE, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D6236 Waterside, Stratford upon Avon between Bridge Street and Chapel Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate essential drain maintenance and a trial deployment of flood barrier.

The Order will commence on 7 November 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 7 November 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Bridge Street, High Street, Chapel Street & Chapel Lane.
