ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D6350 MIDDLETOWN, MORETON MORRELL

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D6350 Middletown, Moreton Morrell to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway patching works.

The Order will commence on 11 January 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 11 January 2018, weather permitting.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C71 DARLINGSCOTT ROAD & D6562 VILLAGE ROAD, DARLINGSCOTT

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing C71 Darlingscott Road & D6562 Village Road, Darlingscott at the junction of Darlingscote Road and Village Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of new drainage and relaying of kerbing.

The Order will commence on 11 January 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 15 January 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Darlingscott Road, Fosse Way, Village Road and vice road.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WELFORD ROAD, LONG MARSTON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Welford Road, Long Marston Road closed from a point near Barley Fields, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for a new sewer connection.

The Order will commence on 8 January 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 12 January 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Main Street, Welford Road, Long Marston Road, Barton Road, Dorsington Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PRESTON FIELDS LANE, MILCOTE

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Preston Fields Lane, Milcote from a point opposite Preston Fields house, on Preston Fields Lane to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of a new stop tap.

The Order will commence on 9 January 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 11 January 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Preston Fields Lane, Milcote Road, Clifford Road, and Campden Road (and vice versa).
