

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(PART OF FOOTPATH SS167 WHATCOTE)  
PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT  
ORDER 2017**

On 12 December 2017 Warwickshire County Council confirmed the above Order made under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed EXTINGUISH the full length and width of Footpath SS167 from its junction with Footpath SS167a at Point A (grid reference 42965 24466) running generally east for approximately 180 metres to the property boundary of Denwyn at Point B (grid reference 42983 24464) as shown on the Order Plan.

A copy of the Order and the Order Plan have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Warwickshire County Council, Shire Hall, Market Square, Warwick CV34 4SA from 8am - 5.30pm on weekdays, (5pm Fridays) and 9am - 4pm Saturdays. A copy of the Order and Order Plan may be bought there at the price of £5.66. Copies may also be inspected at the offices of the Stratford On Avon District Council, Elizabeth House, Church Street, Stratford Upon Avon CV37 6HX, from 8.45am to 5.15pm Monday to Wednesday, and from 8.45am to 5.00pm Thursday to Friday and online at [www.warwickshire.gov.uk/pathorders](http://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/pathorders).

The Order comes into force on 19 December 2017 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or if any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 14 December 2017 make an application to the High Court.
