ROAD TRAFFIC REGIJI ATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF

WATERY LANE, SHIPSTON-ON-STOUR

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Watery Lane, Shipston-on-Stour to vehicular traffic.
