## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF KISSING TREE WAY, ALVESTON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Kissing Tree Way, Alveston to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works to connect a water pipe.

The Order will commence on 16 April 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20 April 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Kissing Tree Lane, The Rookery, Alveston Leys, Church Lane, Kissing Tree Way (and vice versa).

The temporary speed limit is required for the safety of all road users and of the contractors working on the carriageway.

The Order will commence on 1 April 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 30 September 2018.

Please note: The speed restriction will only be imposed whilst convoy work for surface dressing is being carried out to each road – advance signage will be in place as appropriate.

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PERCY STREET, STRATFORD UPON AVON

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SMITHS LANE, SNITTERFIELD

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of a new water pipe.

The Order will commence on 11 April 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 13 April 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Bearley Road, Snitterfield Road, Birmingham Road, Gospel Oak Lane, Kings Lane, Ingon Lane, White Horse Hill, Smiths Lane (and vice versa).
