ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DRAYTON MANOR DRIVE, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Drayton Manor Drive, Stratford upon Avon from a point outside Drayton Experimental Husbandry Farm, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of a duct in the carriageway.

The Order will commence on 9 April 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 11 April 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAIN STREET, TYSOE

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SMITHS LANE, SNITTERFIELD

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BANBURY ROAD, ETTINGTON
