

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SANDPITS ROAD, TYSOE

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Sandpits Road, Tysoe from the junction of Main Street to the junction of Oxhill Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for a new sewer connection.

The Order will commence on 21 May 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 25 May 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Main Street, Oxhill Road (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROGERS LANE, ETTINGTON

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHURCH LANE, SHOTTERY

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D6229 SCHOLARS LANE, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D6229 Scholars Lane, Stratford upon Avon from its junction with Chapel Street to a point outside property number 38, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to enable works to site a crane on the carriageway.
