

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF GORCOTT HILL, WELLESBOURNE

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Gorcott Hill, Wellesbourne, from a point adjacent to the property known as "The Old Boot Barn," to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the connection of new water supplies. The Order will commence on 14 June 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 18 June 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C71 DARLINGSCOTE ROAD, SHIPSTON ON STOUR

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing C71 Darlingscote Road, Shipston on Stour, from the junction with A429 Fosse Way to the junction with Tilemans Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required for carriageway patching.

The Order will commence on 29 May 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 1 June 2018.

Please note: The works will be carried out between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs daily.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Darlingscote Road, Campden Road, (A429) Fosse Way and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CAMPDEN ROAD, SHIPSTON ON STOUR

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Campden Road, Shipston on Stour from the junction with A425 to the junction with High Street, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate foul sewer and electrical works and construction of a site entrance.

The Order will commence on 11 June 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 22 June 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times.

Please note: Access to frontages and housing estates will be maintained.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Campden Road, Fosse Way, Shipston Road, Stratford Road, Church Street, Mill Street, New Street, West Street, High Street (and vice versa).

Proposed Loading Only Bay (Replacing existing Blue Badge Parking Bay)

South side, from a point 6 metres south-east of its junction with Windsor Street, south-eastwards for 12 metres
