## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE GREEN, STRETTON ON FOSSE

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing The Green, Stretton on Fosse from a point outside property number 4, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of a water pipe.

The Order will commence on 10 July 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 13 July 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: The Green, Belcony, School Lane, Church Lane (and vice versa).

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH SB40 IN THE PARISH OF STRATFORD UPON AVON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpath SB40 in the Parish of Stratford upon Avon, at grid reference SP19453-53372, to all traffic.

The closure is required to avoid the likelihood of danger to the public as the result of the dangerous condition of the bridge.

The Order will commence on 22 June 2018 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until remedial works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed, if any, will be maintained.

An alternative route will be signed.

## THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (B4632 CAMPDEN ROAD, MAIN ROAD & STATION ROAD, MEON VALE/LOWER QUINTON) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2018

Warwickshire County Council propose to make the following Orders pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:-

1. The Warwickshire County Council (B4632 Campden Road, Main Road & Station Road, Meon Vale/Lower Quinton) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2018; and
2. The Warwickshire County Council (Various Roads, District of Stratford on Avon) (Speed Limit) (Variation) Order 2018;

the effect of which will be to impose 40 mph speed limits on the lengths of road described in the Schedule below.

A copy of the proposed Orders, together with a plan showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders, may be inspected at the Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick, at the Stratford-on-Avon District Council, Elizabeth House, Church Street, Stratford-upon-Avon and at the Public Library, Henley Street, Stratford upon Avon during usual opening hours.

### SCHEDULE

#### **(Proposed 40 mph Speed Limit)**

#### B4632 Campden Road, Meon Vale/Lower Quinton

That length of road which extends from a point 67 metres south of its junction with Chatham Road/Wellington Avenue, in a northerly direction to a point 213 metres north of its junction with Station Road.

#### Main Road, Lower Quinton

That length of road which extends from its junction with the B4632 Campden Road, in an easterly direction for 271 metres.

#### Station Road, Meon Vale/Lower Quinton

That length of road which extends from its junction with the B4632 Campden Road, in a north-westerly direction for 923 metres.
