ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984. SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF

WATERY LANE, SHIPSTON ON STOUR

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Watery Lane. Shipston on Stour to vehicular traffic

The closure is required to allow for a safe environment for engineers to work in an underground structure. PLEASE NOTE: The work will be carried out daily

between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs. The Order will commence on 17 December 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by

21 December 2018. Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access

will be maintained where possible. An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Watery Lane, Stratford Road, Station Road (and

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STRATFORD ROAD, LOXLEY

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Stratford Road, Loxley, from a point opposite Hawthorne Cottage, to

vehicular traffic. The closure is required to facilitate excavation works

for the connection of new water plots onto the mains. The Order will commence on 2 January 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 5 January 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Stratford Road, Main Road, Goldicote Road, Blue Lane, Banbury Road, The Belt, Shipston Road, Tiddington Road, Loxley Road, Alveston Hill (and vice versa).
