

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISTRICT OF STRATFORD ON AVON) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION NO. 3) ORDER 2019**

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named Variation Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which is to vary the existing District of Stratford on Avon (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017, as briefly described (by approximate measurements) in the Schedules below. The Order commences on Monday 14 January 2019.

A copy of the Variation Order, together with a copy of the Order being varied, plans showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Variation Order may be inspected at the Warwickshire County Council Main Reception, Shire Hall, Market Place, Warwick; at Stratford on Avon District Council, Elizabeth House, Church Street, Stratford on Avon; and at the Public Library, Henley Street, Stratford upon Avon during usual opening hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Variation Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Variation Order may within six weeks from the date of the making of the Variation Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14**  
**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHURCH CLOSE, LUDDINGTON**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Church Close, Luddington, from a point outside property number 2 and across the carriageway to a point outside property number 6, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the laying of poly duct in the footway, the verge and the carriageway.

The Order will commence on 29 January 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 31 January 2019.

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BUCKLEY GREEN LANE, BEAUDESERT**

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BURFORD ROAD, STRATFORD UPON AVON**

The closure is required to facilitate works for the renewal of a water pipe.

The Order will commence on 28 January 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 31 January 2019.

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SCHOLARS LANE, STRATFORD UPON AVON**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Scholars Lane, Stratford upon Avon, from the junction with Chapel Street to a point outside the entrance to The Studio, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to avoid the likelihood of danger to the public whilst utility works are carried out.

The Order will commence on 28 January 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 31 January 2019.

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROTHER STREET, STRATFORD UPON AVON**

The closure is required to facilitate works for the rebuilding of a sluice valve chamber.
