

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D5452 WYRE LANE, LONG MARSTON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D5452 Wyre Lane, Long Marston from its junction with Pear Tree Close, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to facilitate footway construction and associated works. The Order will commence on 13 February 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 15 February 2019.

PLEASE NOTE: The works will be carried out between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs and the road will be open outside of these hours.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BURFORD ROAD, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Burford Road, Stratford upon Avon, from a point outside property number 8, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the renewal of a water pipe.

The Order will commence on 28 January 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 31 January 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SCHOLARS LANE, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Scholars Lane, Stratford upon Avon, from the junction with Chapel Street to a point outside the entrance to The Studio, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to avoid the likelihood of danger to the public whilst utility works are carried out.

The Order will commence on 28 January 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 31 January 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Scholars Lane, Rother Street, Chestnut Walk, Church Street (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHURCH CLOSE, LUDDINGTON

TEMPORARY MPH SPEED LIMIT - D6517 BACK LANE, LOWER QUINTON & D6524 TAILORS LANE, UPPER QUINTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order the effect of which will be to impose a temporary speed limit of 30mph on the above named roads as indicated below.

Back Lane – from the existing 30 mph limit to its junction with B4632 Campden Road.

Tailors Lane – from the existing 30 mph limit to its junction with the B4632 Campden Road.

The temporary speed limit is required for the safety of all road users while footway construction, carriageway and utility works are in progress on nearby roads.

The Order will commence on 22 January 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 February 2019.

THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (B439, BIDFORD ON AVON) (30 & 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (VARIATION NO. 1) ORDER 2019
