

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TYSOE ROAD, LITTLE KINETON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Tysoe Road, Little Kineton to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate excavation works in the road.

The Order will commence on 25 February 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 15 March 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Tysoe Road, Bridge Street, Warwick Road, Banbury Street, Banbury Road, Edge Hill Lane (and vice versa).

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HIGH CROSS LANE, CLAVERDON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing High Cross Lane, Claverdon, from a point approximately 30 metres from the junction with Shrewley Common, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate utility works.

The Order will commence on 25 February 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 27 February 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Shrewley Common, Back Lane, High Cross Farm Road, High Cross Lane (and vice versa).

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF COMMON LANE, CLAVERDON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Common Lane, Claverdon from a point outside the property known as Little Cottage to a point opposite the property known as Heath Cottage, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the installation of poly duct in the verge and carriageway.

The Order will commence on 27 February 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 1 March 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
