

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14  
THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (D6237 SOUTHERN  
LANE & D6236 WATERSIDE, STRATFORD UPON AVON)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2019 &  
THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CHAPEL LANE,  
STRATFORD UPON AVON) (TEMPORARY REVERSAL OF ONE  
WAY ORDER) ORDER 2019 &  
THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CHAPEL LANE,  
D6237 SOUTHERN LANE & D6236 WATERSIDE, STRATFORD  
UPON AVON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING)  
ORDER 2019**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make Temporary Traffic Order closing D6237 Southern Lane & D6236 Waterside, Stratford upon Avon from its junction with Chapel Lane to its junction with Old Town, to vehicular traffic, to prohibit the waiting of vehicles in Southern Lane, Waterside and Chapel Lane and to reverse the One Way traffic flow on Chapel Lane.

The closure is required to safely facilitate works to clean and jet drains on both sides of the carriageway and to enable carriageway resurfacing and associated works.

The prohibition of waiting on Southern Lane and Waterside is required to allow the contractors unimpeded access to the drainage systems.

The prohibition of waiting and the one-way reversal on Chapel Lane are required to safely facilitate a diversion route for all traffic.

The Order will commence on 10 March 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 22 March 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

A diversion route will be signed and is available via: Chapel Lane, Chapel Street, Church Street and Old Town (**ONE WAY ONLY**).

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C47 STATION ROAD,  
LONG MARSTON**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing C47 Station Road, Long Marston, from its junction with B4632 Campden Road to its junction with the access to Bird Industrial Park, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate drainage works, verge stabilisation and associated works

The Order will commence on 11 March 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 22 March 2019.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The works will be carried out between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs on week days only and that the road will be open outside of these hours.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D5446 DRAYTON MANOR DRIVE,  
STRATFORD UPON AVON**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D5446 Drayton Manor Drive, Stratford upon Avon, in its entirety from its junction with A46 Alcester Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway resurfacing.

The Order will commence on 9 March 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 17 March 2019.

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A422 BANBURY ROAD & A422  
THE BELT, STRATFORD UPON AVON**

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF COMMON LANE, CLAVERDON**
