

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D5796 AYLSTONE CLOSE, LOWER QUINTON
Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D5796 Aylstone Close, Lower Quinton in its entirety from its junction with Main Street (Main Road), to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway patching works.
