ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SHEEP STREET, SHIPSTON ON STOUR

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Sheep Street, Shipston on Stour, outside properties number 18-24, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to facilitate utility works.

The Order will commence on 3 June 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 6 June 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible. An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Darlingscote Road, Church Street, Telegraph Street, Market Place, Sheep Street (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH BETWEEN CANNERS WAY AND BIRMINGHAM ROAD, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Public Footpath between Canners Way and Birmingham Road, Stratford upon Avon, to all traffic. The closure is required to safely facilitate the laying of an electricity cable.

The Order will commence on 17 June 2019 and will last for a period of 6 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 June 2019.

Access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of footpath to be closed will be maintained where possible. An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Birmingham Road, Hamlet Way, Canners Way (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BURFORD LANE, ASTON CANTLOW

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Burford Lane, Aston Cantlow, from a point outside Pear Tree Cottage, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to facilitate excavation works to enable connection of new water plots.

The Order will commence on 3 June 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 6 June 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible. An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Burford Lane, Shelfield Green, Alne Hills, Spennall Lane, Spennal Lane, Village Road, Alne End, Henley Road, Alcester Road (and vice versa).
