

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SCHOLARS LANE, STRATFORD UPON AVON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Scholars Lane, Stratford upon Avon between properties 19 and 22, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required for utility works.

The Order will commence on 2 July 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 4 July 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible. An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Chestnut Walk, Scholars Lane, Rother Street, Church Street (and vice versa).
